Yesterday In 1980
 This morning Last (year)

- Verleden
- Nu afgelopen
- Tijdstip vaak aangegeven

Present simple (PR.S) ww, behalve bij She, He, IT

I work every day / He works every day

Sometimes Always
 Often Never Every

SHIT-rule

- Feit
- Gewoonte

Future simple (F.S) will + ww

What will you do when you are in London? You = nooit shall

Shall I come with you? Vraag + voorstel + I = shall ← **shall + ww**

- Gaat waarschijnlijk in de toekomst gebeuren
- Spontaan besluit
- Will → alle personen (altijd bij bevestiging)
- Belofte
- Shall → Vraagzin alleen bij I / we; voorstel doen

Past continuous (P.C) was / were + ww + ing

Yesterday he was shopping for two hours

When As
 While For

- Tijdje in verleden
- Nu afgelopen
- Tijdstip vaak aangegeven
- Vaak P.S (kort) / P.C (lang)

Present continuous (PR.C) to be (am, is are) + ww + ing

I am working right now

At the moment As we speak
 Currently Listen! Now

- Vergelijkbaar met in het NL "Aan het...doen"
- Op dit moment aan de gang
- Nu

Future continuous (F.C) will / shall+ be + ww + ing

Next week we will be walking in Madrid.

Will you be needing the car?

- Aan de gang in de toekomst
- Beleefde manier om te vragen naar iemands plannen

Past perfect (P.P) had + ww + ed

He wasn't (P.S) a stranger, we had met before

After Before When
 As soon as By the time

- Is gebeurd vóór ander moment in verleden
- Vaak combi met P.S

Present perfect (simple) (PR. PS) have / has + vdw.

I have lost my keys

For Since
 Already Never

- In verleden begonnen, tot nu toe
- Resultaat = merkbaar
- Tijdstip onbepaald / onbelangrijk

Future perfect (simple) (F.P.S) will / shall + have + vdw.

At noon, I will have been here for 3 hours.

The mechanic said he will have repaired our car by Tuesday.

- Afgerond op een bepaald/vastgelegd tijdstip in de toekomst

Past perfect continuous (P.P.C) had been + ww + ing

We had been working for hours, when we finally reached (P.S) the village

After Before When
 As soon as By the time

- In het verleden bezig, terwijl er iets gebeurt (P.S)

Present perfect (continuous) (PR. PC) have / has + been + ing

I have been drinking all evening

For Since
 Already Never

- De "simple form" geeft een feit weer, de continuous benadrukt de handeling

Future perfect (continuous) (F.P.C) will + have + been + ww + ing

They will have been screaming for hours, when One Direction starts singing.

He will have been waiting for half a day when that plane finally lands.

- Gebeurtenis in toekomst beschrijven die op een bepaald moment bezig zal zijn (en nog niet afgelopen hoeft te zijn)

Passive (vorm van to be + vdw.)		
Past simple (P.S) She <u>was seen</u> last week was / were + vdw.	Present simple (PR.S) The flowers <u>are never</u> watered by him am / is / are + vdw.	Future perfect simple (F.P.S) The work <u>will be done</u> tomorrow will + be + vdw.
Past continuous (P.C) The cake <u>was being baked</u> for an hour was + being + vdw.	Present continuous (PR. C) The gifts <u>are being opened</u> at the moment am / is / are + being + vdw.	Future continuous (F.C) The car <u>will be being needed</u> next week. will + be + being + vdw.
Past perfect (P.P) The problems <u>had been solved</u> when we arrived (P.S) had + been + vdw.	Present perfect (simple) (PR.PS) The keys <u>have been lost</u> have / has + been + vdw.	Future perfect (simple) (F.P.S) The car <u>will have been repaired</u> by Tuesday will + have / has + been
Past perfect continuous (P.P.C) The pizza's <u>had been being prepared</u> by this chef for two years before he moved (P.S) to Italy had + been + being + vdw.	Present perfect (continuous) (PR.PC) The cow <u>has been being milked</u> all morning have / has + been + being + vdw.	Future perfect (continuous) (F.P.C) I <u>will have been being eating</u> vegetables for three months will + have / has + been + being + vdw.

Will / Going to

I think he will hurt himself.

Look! I think he is going to hurt himself.

- Will = besluiten, beloftes, bedreigingen, voorspelling zonder bewijs
- Going to = zeker dat het gaat gebeuren (= meer dan belofte), voorspelling met bewijs

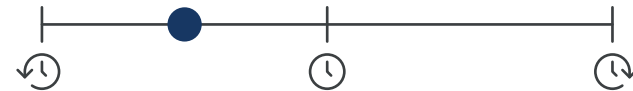
